

Walk-in Clinics Work Better When You Walk in Prepared!

Circle Health Services must gather proof of identity and income from <u>all of our patients</u>. This will help us determine your position on our sliding fee scale.

When you visit our walk-in clinics, please bring with you whichever of the following documents you have that will prove who you are, where you live and how much income you earn.

□ Proof of income (tax returns OR 2 current pay stubs OR W2 form)
☐ Proof of insurance (Medicaid, Medicare, or private insurance)
☐ Social security card
☐ Valid driver's license or state ID
☐ Utility bill
☐ Proof of dependents (such as your child's social security cards or your tax documents)

You may also be eligible for other social programs to help with your medical, food, child care, gas and light needs, among others.

Your walk-in clinic experience will flow more smoothly when you bring this information with you!
